

JUDGES AT RISK

Report of the judge delegates of the Colombia Caravana

In August 2012 the international delegation of lawyers and judges, known as the Colombia Caravana, visited seven regions of Colombia to investigate and monitor human rights. Among the delegates, the judges' special task was to interview members of the Colombian judiciary. Their report tells of the exceptional difficulties faced by judges in Colombia, many of whom receive protective measures from the Colombian authorities. Challenges to the rule of law and to the independence of the judiciary and threats, attacks and assassinations hamper access to justice and the judicial system.
